


Select a workspace. (The workspace name that Eclipse suggests is fine.)




In the Wecome screen, click the Workbench icon.








Select achive file, then Browse to the location of the book's downloaded examples (a .zip file).




Select the zip file containing the book's examples. You'll see a list of Eclipse projects containing the book's code.




Click Finish.
