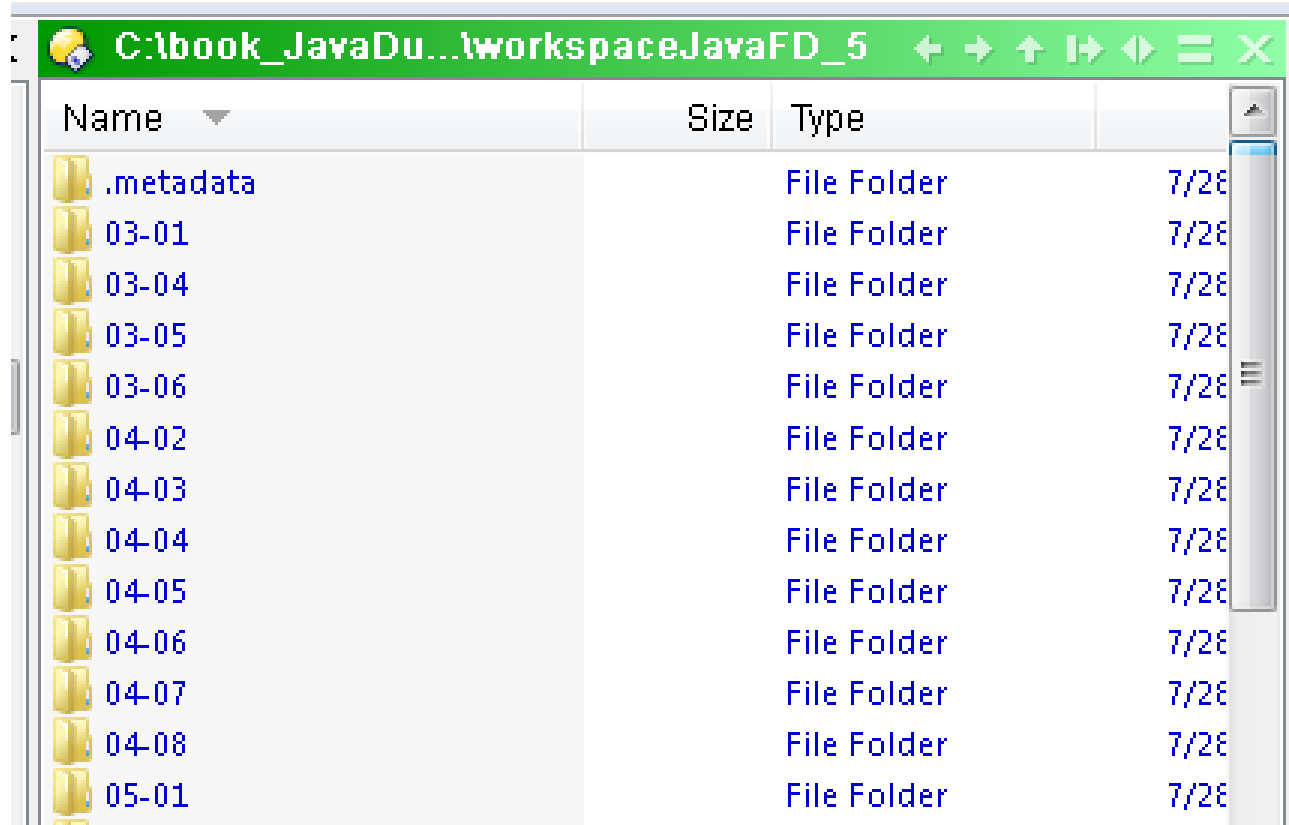

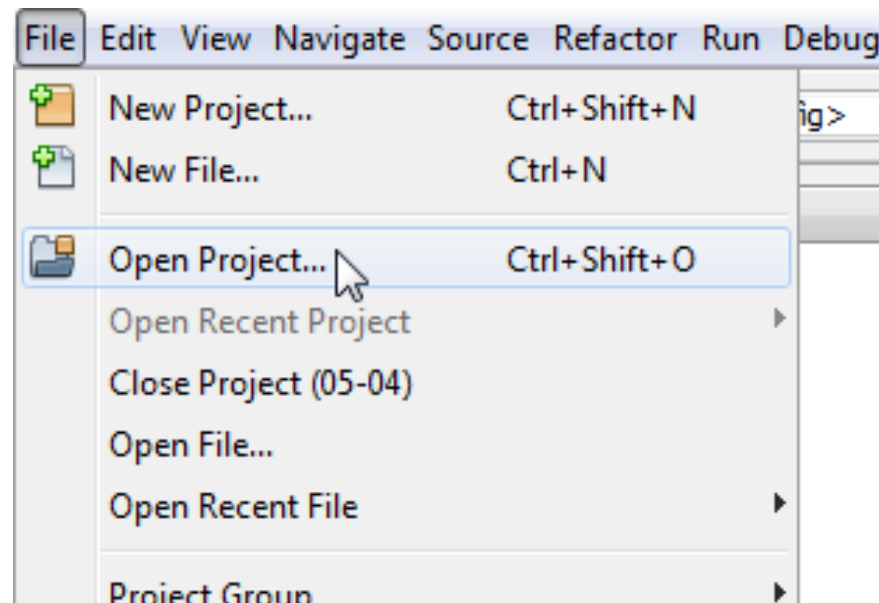
If you have trouble importing your projects into Eclipse, your computer might be automatically unzipping the downloaded file.

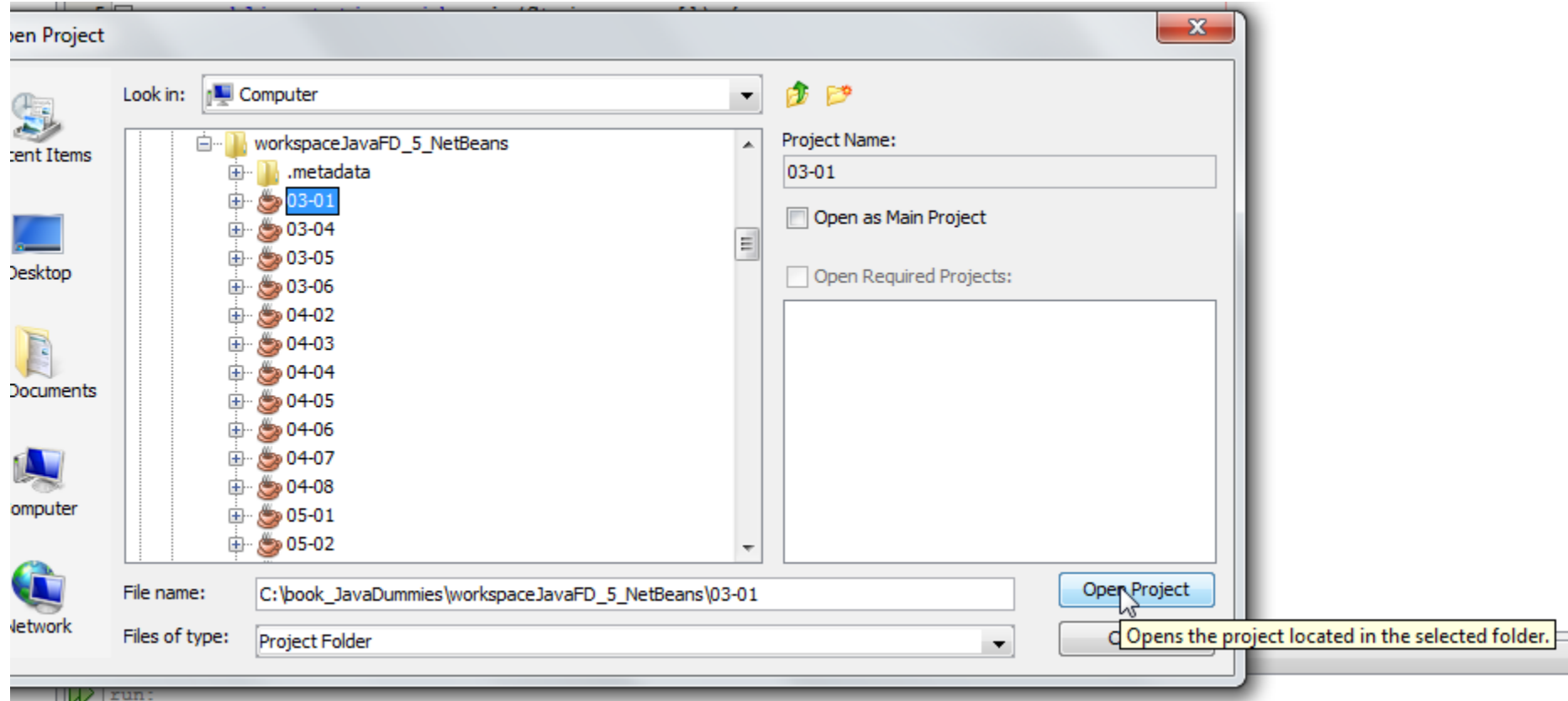
# Extract the contents of the downloaded file



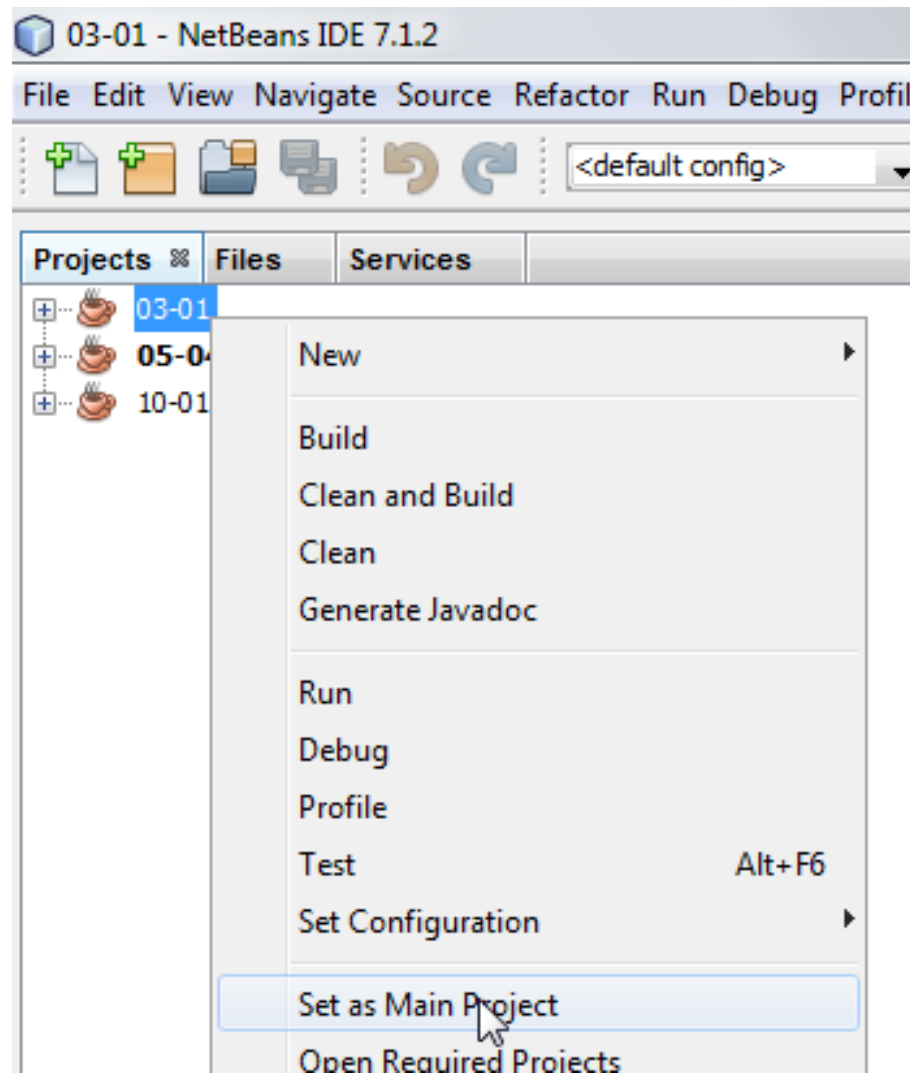
# With NetBeans started, click File→Open Project



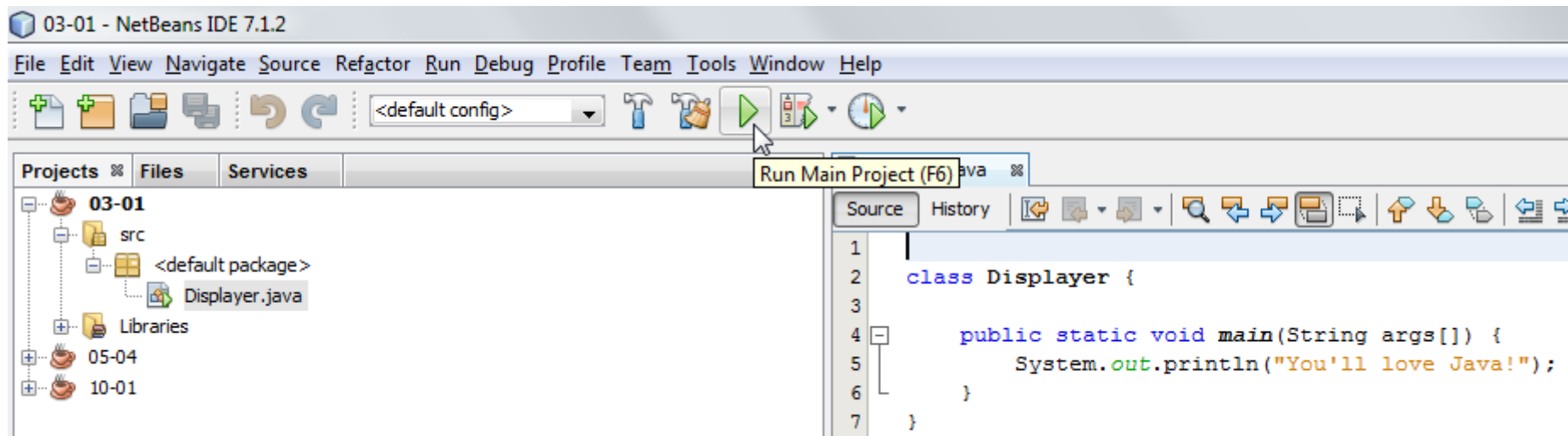
Browse to the location of the downloaded projects. Press the button to open one of the projects.
